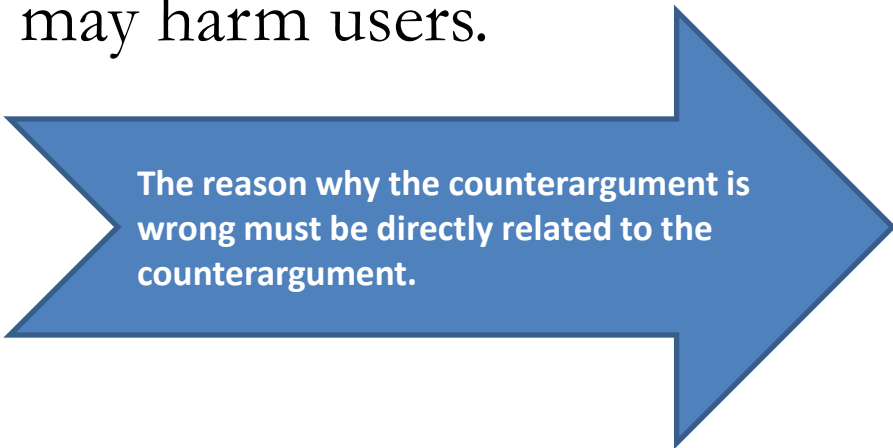
It may be true that social networking sites might pose some security risks.

Sentence 4: Add expert evidence

Major support:

Expert evidence:

According to Edward Jones (2011), the author of the article “How to Use Twitter Safely,” people should know how to use the privacy settings.

Do not forget to cite the author and date of publication of the article. If you do not know the author, cite the name of the article. If you do not know the date of publication, write “n.d.”



Sentence 5: Add examples/statistics

Major support:

One of the main ways to do so is by using the privacy settings.

Even if you paraphrase ideas that are not your own, you **MUST** cite the author and date of publication of the article where you found the information.

Sentence 4 (statistic)

Sentence 6: Add analysis sentence

Topic sentence:

People can easily protect themselves from these security threats.

Analysis (inference):
