Support your thesis (claim) with two arguments (reasons) that prove your thesis (claim) is true. introducing them in a logical order. Then, give more than one piece of evidence to support each reason. Remember, relevant, accurate data and evidence should demonstrate an understanding of the topic and come from credible sources.
