- 2. To avoid the repetition of a single, simple sentence pattern that draws attention to itself rather than to the ideas in the paper

HOW TO USE APPOSITIVES

What is an appositive?

It is a noun or pronoun phrase that identifies, in different words, the noun or pronoun it follows.

Gulf University for Science and Technology, the first private university in Kuwait, is located in West Mishref.

Appositive the first private university in Kuwait identifies noun Gulf University for Science and Technology.

HOW TO USE APPOSITIVES

ORIGINAL: Sacajawea was a pregnant fifteen-year-old Indian woman.

She was married to the French fur-trader named Charbonneau.

Sacajawea accompanied her husband on the expedition.

She served as a translator.

HOW TO USE APPOSITIVES

Decide on the focus of the information.

Sacagiwea served as a translator on the expedition.

What is a participial phrase?

A participle is a verb form that functions as an adjective by modifying nouns and pronouns. A participle can be either a present participle or a past participle. A participal phrase includes the participle, plus any modifiers and complements.

Frightened by the fireworks, the dog hid under the couch.

- 1. Past participle *Frightened* and prepositional phrase *by the fireworks* combine to form the participial phrase *Frightened by the fireworks*.
- 2. The participial phrase serves as an adjective, modifying the noun *dog*.

REVISED: Injured during the football match, Marco had to leave the pitch.

ORIGINAL: The American labor movement has helped millions of workers. It has won them higher wages and better working conditions.

REVISED: The American labor movement has helped millions of workers, winning them higher wages and better working conditions.

HOW TO USE ABSOLUTE PHRASES

What is an absolute phrase?

An absolute phrase usually consists of a noun or pronoun and a participle, accompanied by modifiers. It is usually located at the beginning of a sentence.

His <u>heart</u> **racing**, he dialed her number.

Noun *heart* is accompanied by participle **racing**.

HOW TO USE ABSOLUTE PHRASES

1. Decide on the focus of the information.

He dialed her number.

2. Identify the details.

His heart was racing.

3. Integrate the details into the focus sentence as appositives.

REVISED: His heart racing, <u>he dialed her</u> number.

Lewis's fame and fortune was virtually guaranteed by his exploits.

Lewis disappointed the entire world by inexplicably failing to publish his journals.

ORIGINAL: Lewis's fame and fortune was virtually guaranteed by his exploits. Lewis disappointed the entire world by inexplicably failing to publish his journals.

REVISED: His fame and fortune virtually guaranteed by his exploits, Lewis disappointed the entire world by inexplicably failing to publish his journals.

Lewis's long journey was finally completed.

His men in the Corps of Discovery were dispersed.

Lewis died a few years later on his way back to Washington, D.C., completely alone.

ORIGINAL: Lewis's long journey was finally completed. His men in the Corps of Discovery were dispersed. Lewis died a few years later on his way back to Washington, D.C., completely alone.

REVISED: His long journey finally completed and his men in the Corps of Discovery dispersed, Lewis died a few years later on his way back to Washington, D.C., completely alone.

ORIGINAL: Notre Dame stood majestically. Its rose window glowed in the darkness.

REVISED: Its rose window glowing in the darkness, Notre Dame stood majestically.
