- aerospace (adjective) having to do with airplanes or spacecraft (الطيران)
  She wanted to become an aerospace engineer and design planes.
- anchor (noun) a weight on the end of a rope or chain that is dropped into the water to keep a boat from moving (مرساة)
   They dropped anchor 400 meters offshore.
- autonomous (adjective) able to operate independently or without the guidance of others (مستقل ناتيا)

The Kurdish people in this region want to be completely autonomous.

- battleship (noun) a large warship with heavy armor and many guns (سفينة حربية)
  The battleship was sailing in the Arabian Gulf.
- community (noun) a social group sharing common interests (مجتمع) The community shared a love of family.
- 6. corroborate (verb) to confirm or give support to something or someone (أكد)
  *His friend corroborated that Abdullah was telling the truth.*
- 7. cultural (adjective) relating to the ideas, activities and behavior of a specific group of people (حضاري)

One thing that people notice about Syrians is that they are very friendly.

- exhibition (noun/adjective) a show for people to see or learn about something, often at a museum (معرض)
  The exhibition featured the works of several famous painters.
- 9. expedite (verb) to ensure that something takes place or is dealt with more quickly than usual (عجل)

If you have wasta, you can expedite the hiring process.

- 10. factor (noun) element contributing to a particular result (عامل) Losing his job is a major factor in Sam's current state of depression.
- 11. **fetid** (adjective) having a heavy offensive smell (نتن) *The dead body had a fetid odor*.
- 12. **founder** (noun) a person who starts a business, group, company, and so on (منشى) Steve Jobs was one of the founders of Apple.
- 13. **image** (noun) a drawing or photograph (صورة) The photographer took horrific images of war.

14. **immerse** (verb) - to completely surround someone; to place someone fully into a certain environment (غمر)

The immigrant became immersed in the foreign culture.

- 15. innovator (noun) one who comes up with new and creative ideas (مبتكر)
- 16. **interactive** (adjective) having to do with back-and-forth "talking" between computers or people (متفاعل)
- 17. participation (noun) taking part in an event or group (مشاركة) The professor gives a participation grade for taking part in group discussions.
- philanthropist (noun) a person who helps others through charitable activities (محسن)
  Philanthropist Warren Buffet has donated millions of dollars to charity.
- 19. preposterous (adjective) ridiculous (مناف للعقل) His claim that he was the smartest person in the world was preposterous.
- 20. **renovation** (noun) a repair or improvement (ترميم) *The renovation of the old building was very expensive.*
- 21. response (noun) an answer (إجابة)

There was no response to my question because everyone was asleep.

- 22. **simulation** (noun) a recreation of the appearance or characteristics of something (محاكاة) Some airlines use simulation to train their pilots how to avoid crashing.
- 23. subsidize (verb) to fund (يتكفل ماديا) The government should subsidize public transportation.
- 24. **technology** (noun) tools and equipment developed from the application of scientific knowledge (تكنولوجيا)

In the last 20 years, there have been amazing developments in computer technology.

- 25. virtual reality (noun/adjective) technology that makes graphics seem real (الواقع الافتراضي) Play Station 3 Home is one of the top ten most popular virtual reality games.
- 26. wreckage (noun) the broken parts of something that has been damaged or destroyed (حطام) Although the auto accident was two days ago, the wreckage had not been removed from the street.
- 27. yacht (noun) a boat with sails and sometimes an engine (يخت) The harbor was full of millionaires' yachts.
