1. belated (adjective) – happening or coming after an expected time (متأخر)
I forgot my friend's birthday, so I had to send her belated birthday greetings.
2. colleague (noun) – a coworker (زميل عمل)
She is a colleague of mine at the bank where I work.
3. dub (verb) – to give a name or a nickname (لقب)
Margaret Thatcher was dubbed "The Iron Lady."
4. exoplanet (noun) – a planet that orbits a star outside of Earth's solar system
Over 2,000 exoplanets have been discovered since 1988.
5. insidious (adjective) – slowly and subtly harmful (غادر)
In the last few years, there has been an insidious trend toward censorship of the press.
6. internment camp (noun) – military prison camp where prisoners of war are held (معسكر اعتقال)
Senator Daniel Inouye and his family were sent to an internment camp during World War II.
7. mentor (noun) – an experienced person who can guide and advise (الناصح)
Support for you in your new job will be provided by a mentor.
8. relinquish (verb) – to give up (تنازل)
Richard stubbornly refused to relinquish his hold on the family business.
9. subsequently (adverb) – in a manner that follows or comes after something else (بعد ذلك)
The book was subsequently translated into 15 languages.
